CODE OF CONDUCT – OFFICIALS

- Always aim to make netball enjoyable and promote fair play.
- Prior to start of play umpires should check all players in accordance to the rules and the safety of the court.
- Umpires will provide their own whistle/ pen / pencil/ scorecard and stopwatch and will carry an up to date rule book when officiating fixtures.
- Umpires will at all times endeavour to Umpire to the best of their ability, keeping up with the pace of the game.
- Umpires will provide clarifications on rules when approached by team Captains during breaks in the game.
- Umpires will be dressed appropriately.
- Umpires will arrange appropriate cover when they are not available to officiate in a fixture that is scheduled for them.
- Never condone rule violations, rough play or the use of any performance enhancing drugs.
- Display consistently high standards of behaviour and appearance.
- Always treat Children and Young People equally, affording respect and dignity.
- Always maintain a safe and appropriate distance with players.
- Always keep up to date with technical knowledge, qualifications and insurance in netball.
